RESTAURANT OX ENGELBERG

Parents can now watch their little ones in the beginners' area, either from the terrace or from the restaurant, which has 170 indoor and 150 outdoor seats. The restaurant level is made entirely of timber (spruce), much of which remains visible in the interior. An acoustic ceiling from the Renggli factory is suspended to help reduce noise emissions. The restaurant has two dining rooms, with the kitchen infrastructure in the middle. A lounge is also available to relax in.
